## 2013 Flounder Bowl Tournament Rules:

1. Official tournament starting time is 6:00 AM (lines in the water) on June 29, 2013 and will terminate at 5:00 PM that same day. You can leave from any port. Fish can be brought by car or boat but must be weighed at Dare Marina and you must be standing in the weigh-in line by 5:00 PM.
  2. There will be a tournament meeting on Friday, June 28, 2013 7:00 PM, at Dare Marina. At least one member from each team must attend.
  3. This is a boat tournament. Each boat may weigh-in up to 3 flounder. Winners will be determined by the combined weight of the team's fish. Entry fee for each boat is \$125 up to 4 anglers, \$25 each additional angler. Early Bird Entry \$100 if received by June 12th.
  4. Teams must be registered prior to 6:00 AM of the day of the tournament. Proof of tournament registration must be presented to the weigh master when entering fish.
  5. Fish must be caught by rod and reel only.
  6. All fish are subject to thorough examination, both external and internal by the tournament committee of the PSWSFA.
  7. In the event of a tie, the first team checked in at the weigh-in will be declared the winner.
  8. Anglers are urged to display proper boat handling and courtesy towards others.
  9. Anglers are advised to maintain an active weather watch when fishing Virginia's waters. The captain and crew must decide on their own when and where to fish during this tournament and they are solely responsible for their safety.
  10. Anglers will be required to submit to a sworn affidavit, if asked, and take a lie detector test, if deemed necessary, which will be provided by the tournament committee. These may be required at any time and for any reason deemed appropriate by the tournament committee.
  11. Anglers are responsible for all applicable taxes on prizes received. Winners shall allow the PSWSFA and the sponsors the opportunity and right to film, videotape, record, and photograph the winners and to use the prize winner's name, voice and likeness without further compensation for advertising and promotion of the PSWSFA and the sponsors.
  12. All participants agree that the PSWSFA, Dare Marina, and any sponsor of this tournament shall not be liable for injury, loss, or damage of any kind resulting from participation in this tournament or from the acceptance or use of any awarded prize.
  13. Any protest must be filed by 5:30 PM on the day of the tournament. The protest must be made directly to an official of the tournament committee. The tournament committee will review any and all protests and their decisions will be final.
  14. No fish caught during the act of commercial fishing will be eligible.
  15. Any fish entered in or with another contest or tournament, outside of the PSWSFA, shall be ineligible for entry into this tournament.
  16. Any contestant found guilty of cheating, attempting to cheat, or otherwise deviating from the regulations of this tournament, shall be disqualified and considered ineligible for further and future participation and will be prosecuted.
  17. Tournament committee members are not eligible to fish in this tournament. They will be identified at the Tournament Meeting on June 28, 2013.
  18. The Tournament Committee shall consist of a minimum of three people; a director and two assistants all sanctioned by the PSWSFA.
  19. If small craft advisories are posted at 5:00 AM the day of the tournament for the area from New Point Comfort to Little Creek, the tournament will be postponed until the next "blow date." The scheduled blow day will be Sunday, June 30, 2013. Small craft advisory information shall be as announced by NOAA and obtained from the weather channel on marine VHF radio. Next blow day would be the following Saturday.
  20. Fish that will be entered into the tournament **must be tagged** with tags that will be supplied at the tournament meeting.
  21. There will be an optional big fish Calcutta with an entry fee of \$100 per boat. The single heaviest fish wins. You must tag your Calcutta fish with the special tag provided. In case of a tie, the first fish weighed will be declared the winner.
  22. There will be a second optional "stringer" calcutta for \$100 with a 100% payout to the heaviest stringer entered in this calcutta.
  23. 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$5,000.00 guaranteed, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 30% not to exceed \$2,000.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 20% not to exceed \$1,500.00, 4<sup>th</sup> Place: 10% not to exceed \$1,000.00, 5<sup>th</sup> Place: 5% not to exceed \$500.00, 6<sup>th</sup> Place: 5% not to exceed \$250.00, "Lucky Dog": \$500.00.
  24. Sponsors Challenge Division - \$250, Sponsor will be entered into the regular division and separate sponsor's division.
  25. "Lucky Dog" payout -10% of regular entries up to a maximum of \$500. Teams not placing in the top 6 will be entered into a "Lucky Dog" drawing. A member of the team must be present to win. If no member of the winning team is present, another team will be drawn.
  26. Ladies Division - The largest fish wins \$100.00. In case of a tie, the first fish brought in will win. Fish may also be entered in main event.
  27. Youth Division - children 15 years old and under may participate. The largest fish wins \$100.00. In case of a tie, the first fish brought in will win. Fish may also be entered in main event.
  28. Club Member \$500 Division - The club member with the largest fish wins \$500.00.
