Deb Gauthier, Marine Scientist at VIMS, gave a great presentation on the ChesMMAP (Chesapeake Bay Multispecies Monitoring and Assessment Program) and the Trawl Survey Program (NEAMAP) at VIMS.

There were otoliths (ear bone) displays of different fish species which is a way to determine the age of the fish.



Deb also explained about the survey data. One item that I found of interest is the eating habits of the fish throughout the years. Knowing what the fish are eating could be the difference between an okay day of fishing or an awesome day. Fish change their eating habits to adjust to their environment.
