The VA Saltwater Sport Fishing Tournament Advisory Committee voted to end part of the citation program. All levels of master angler past One have been eliminated for 2014. The system was set up so at each level Master level I, II, III etc. you had to catch 25 citation and only one citation per species per year would count towards the 25 total. Also to qualify for each level you would have to have a certain number of different species .After getting level one you would need five more different species in your total count, level II 10 different species in the total count from level I and II. Then level III 15 different species from the total count of 75 citation from level I, II and III. Because there are only so many species the levels would end. It is my understanding a level was given that mathematical

was impossible so the committee decide to eliminate the program instead of fixing the problem. It is also my understanding that every committee member was not in favor of this action, as well as Lewis Gillingham who is head of the citation program (Also it is my understanding Lewis does not vote, only the committee members vote on it). If you are in favor of the different Master Level programs I am asking you to send Lewis a letter (e-mail is fine) and tell him you want the program back.

Now why did I post this. I used the program to set goal and push myself to fish for different species out of my comfort zone and to go fishing when I would want stay in when it is to cold, to hot, to calm, to windy, to sunny, to rainy or any other excuse.
