Sportsmanship and conservation go hand in hand – anglers who hope for more and bigger fish tomorrow invariably understand the need to release catches they make today. Since 1993, the International Game Fish Association (IGFA) has been recognizing superlative achievements in fishing conservation with the annual IGFA Conservation Awards, bestowed upon honorees at the yearly IGFA International Auction & Banquet. This year the organization will give Conservation Awards in three categories at the event on January 31, 2014 at their headquarters in Dania Beach, Florida, USA:

With the family, friends, and crew who fish with him aboard *Healthy Grin*, Dr. Neill has contributed to a number of tagging studies and sample collection efforts. Of the dozens of projects *Healthy Grin* has been thanked for contributing to, Neill reports that some of the most rewarding are the few that have led directly to fishery management decisions. "By capturing young-of the-year bluefin tuna and collecting tissue samples from bluefin tuna of all sizes, as well as participating in a variety of bluefin tagging projects," Neill reports, "we have helped scientists better understand the relationships between the western and eastern stocks of Atlantic bluefin tuna. This information is now being used in international management decisions."



Special Meeting of Saltwater Tournament Committee Set

A special meeting of the Tournament Committee of the Virginia Saltwater Fishing Tournament will be held Tuesday, February 18th at 2600 Washington Avenue, Newport News, 7 PM, in the Virginia Marine Resources Commission's meeting room, located on the fourth floor of the building. The meeting was scheduled in response to a significant number of requests for the Committee to reconsider their decision, made during their annual meeting in November 2013, to eliminate the multiple tiers of the Master Angler Program as originally designed. The multiple tier design was modeled after a similar and popular program run by the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

The meeting will begin with a public comment period, providing anglers an opportunity to address the Committee with their suggestions and concerns relating to the operation and policies of the Master Angler Program. Following the public comment period, the Committee will deliberate the merits and drawbacks of the original Master Angler Program and consider modifying their November decision. At the discretion of the Committee the public may be given time for additional comments.

The Tournament Committee meets at least annually to review and set minimum qualifying weights and lengths for species eligible in the State's popular recognition program. Additionally the Committee can consider changes to the Tournament's rules regarding Citations and State Records and any other of its associated recognition programs. Written comments will be accepted until 5 PM, February 18th and provided to the Committee at the start of their meeting at 7 PM.
